**High Road, Fobbing Level Crossing, Fobbing
(Temporary prohibition or restriction on roads)
No. 57 Order 2018**

- 1) The Borough Council of Thurrock, in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other powers, intends to make an Order the effect of which is to: -

**Prohibit any vehicle from travelling across Fobbing Level Crossing,
High Road, Fobbing.**

- 2) The purpose of the Order is to enable Network Rail to carry out maintenance to the Level Crossing.
- 3) The alternative route for northbound vehicles is High Road, Lion Hill, Fobbing Road, B1420 Lampits Hill, Southend Road and vice versa for Southbound vehicles.
- 4) The Order will come into force on Sunday 20th May 2018 at 02:00hrs until Sunday 20th May 2018 at 23:59hrs. It only applies to those days and times when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 5) It is expected that the works will be completed within the above times, however the Order will continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 6) If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the approval of the Secretary of State.
