

PUBLIC NOTICE

**High Road, Fobbing
(Temporary prohibition or restriction on roads)
No. 062 Order 2019**

- 1) The Borough Council of Thurrock, in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other powers, intends to make an Order the effect of which is to: -

Prohibit any vehicle from travelling along High Road, Fobbing, from its junction with Whitehall Lane for a distance of approximately 260m southwards.

- 2) The purpose of the Order is to enable resurfacing of the carriageway to be carried out by Thurrock Council.
- 3) The alternative route for southbound vehicles is High Road, Five Bells Roundabout, Southend Road, Lampits Hill, Fobbing Road, and High Road and vice versa for northbound vehicles.
- 4) The Order will come into force on Thursday 13th June 2019 until Friday 14th June 2019 between the hours of 08:00 and 17:00. It only applies to those days and times when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 5) It is expected that the works will be completed within the above times, however the Order will continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 6) If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the approval of the Secretary of State.
