

PUBLIC NOTICE

TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

The Borough of Thurrock **(Lampits Lane & Woolifers Avenue, Corringham & Rodings Avenue, SLH)** **(No Waiting At Any Time) Order 2018**

- 1) Notice is hereby given that Thurrock Borough Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby gives notice that they have made the above order on the 14th November 2018. The order will come into force on the 13th December 2018.
- 2) The general effect of the Order would be to
 - a) introduce a new Waiting restriction “No Waiting At Any Time” at the locations specified below: -
 - I. Lampits Lane / Lampits Hill south junction, Corringham.
 - II. Lampits Lane / Lampits Hill Avenue junction, Corringham.
 - III. Lampits Lane junction with the access road for 31-39 Lampits Lane, Corringham.
 - IV. Lampits Lane / Edith Way, Corringham
 - V. Lampits Lane / Lampits Hill north junction, Corringham.
 - VI. Rodings Avenue / Second Avenue junction, opposite 68 Rodings Avenue, SLH.
 - VII. Rodings Avenue / Second Avenue junction, opposite 19 Second Avenue, SLH.
 - VIII. Rodings Avenue, north side from the west boundary of 38 to the North boundary of 48, SLH.
 - IX. Woolifers Avenue, north west kerb line from a point 23.1m north of south west boundary of No. 1 Woolifers Avenue southwards for a distance of 50.3m.
 - X. Woolifers Avenue, south west kerb line from a point 0.5m north of the boundary of Nos.1 and 3 Woolifers Avenue extending southwards for a distance of 5.5m.
 - b) to revoke the following Waiting restrictions “No waiting Mon-Sat 8am – 6pm” at the locations specified below:-
 - i) Woolifers Avenue north west for 50.3m.
 - ii) Woolifers Avenue south west for 4.7m.

- 3) A copy of the Proposed Order together with the plans will be available for inspection for a period of 21 days at the Civic Offices, New Road, Grays, RM17 6SL during normal office hours and also on Thurrock Council's website at thurrock.gov.uk/publicnotices
- 4) Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for purpose to the High Court.
